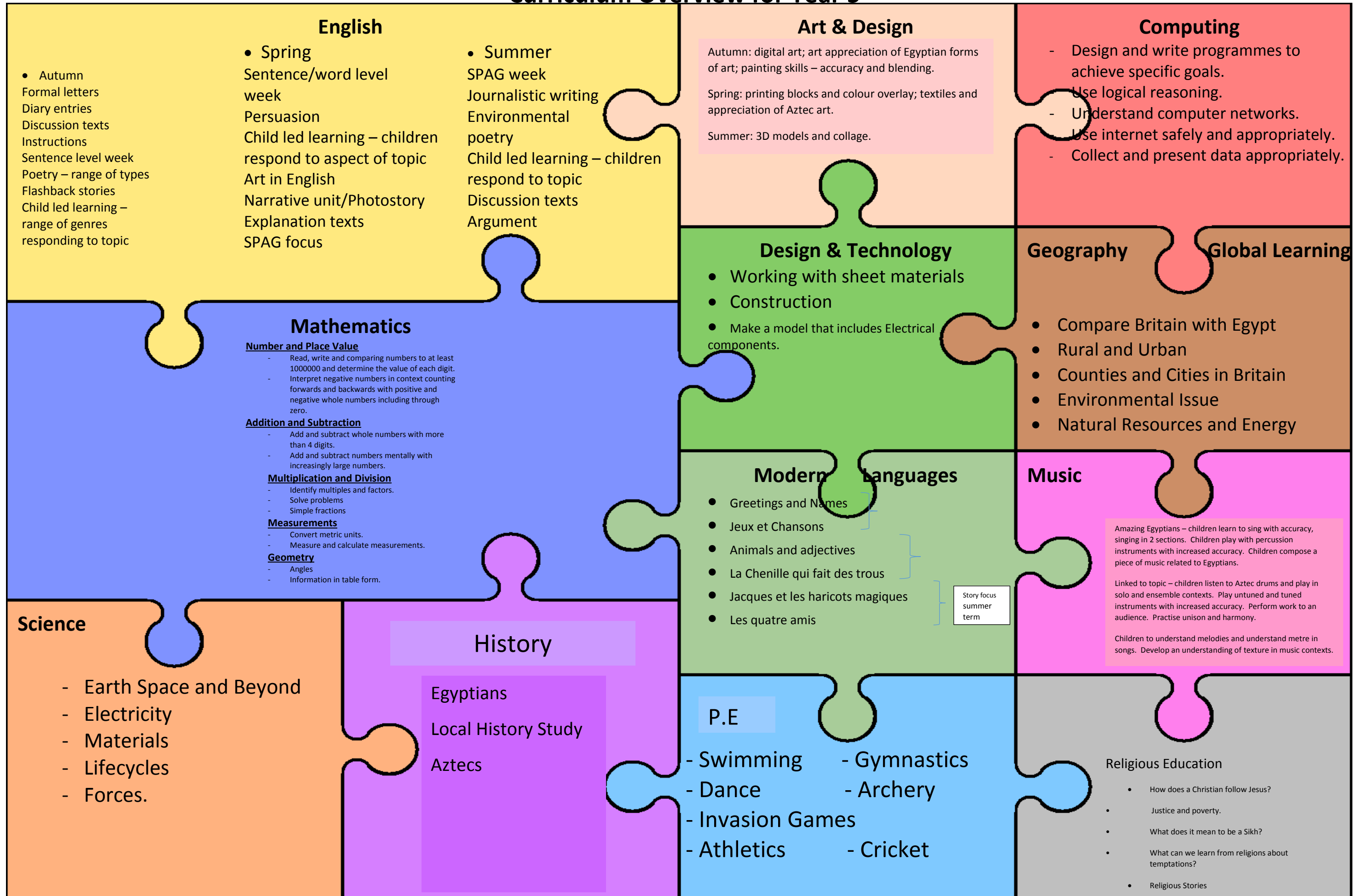


Curriculum Overview for Year 5
