#### Where does the money go?

The PTA is run by parents and teachers and raises money and supports our school by helping pay for the extras to enrich your child's time here at NJS. All money raised goes back to school on items the PTA agree to fund which are requested by the staff or school council.

During 2014/2015 school year we raised just short of £3000 which was used to buy new laptops, a metal storage shed, playtime equipment, Panto and Grand Day Out refreshments, Year 6 Leavers Hoodies, Art **Equipment for all year groups and Christmas Presents for** all children.

We also have allocated funds (£5000) raised in recent years to part fund the new Children's Kitchen Classroom which is being built as we speak. It will be open for use very soon.

What are we planning to fund next?

This term we are funding new music equipment and raising money for iPads to be used across all year groups to support the new ICT curriculum. As the year progresses and with your continued support we will be raising money for other items on the school's wish list.
