WOODWIND TUITION AT NEWPORT JUNIOR SCHOOL

Dear Parent / Carer,

I am a professional musician and qualified teacher who gives individual woodwind tuition at a number of schools in the Telford area.

I currently have vacancies for pupils wishing to learn to play the clarinet, saxophone, flute or recorder. Lessons currently take place on a Thursday during the school day. As far as practicable, lessons are organised on a rotating basis so that pupils do not miss the same classroom lesson every week.

My terms and conditions are available on request; please note that by commencing lessons for your child you have agreed to abide by these. Pupils are expected to commit to lessons for a term, after which a notice period of six weeks is required for termination of lessons.

You will be invoiced for lessons on a monthly basis and payment is to be made in time for the first lesson of each month. The cost of lessons is currently £14.20 for a 30 minute lesson, this is reviewed every April.

It is preferable that pupils have their own instrument, but please note that there are a number of school clarinets, flutes and saxophones available for pupils to use.
