Where does the money raised go... Since September the PTA has funded new musical instruments for use in school, a Christmas gift for every child in school and water, flapjack and sweets for every child at the Pantomime. We have also spent the £5,000 that was raised a few years ago to help fund the Kitchen Classroom. This has been used to help furnish and kit out this fantastic new facility in school which should be ready for the children to use any day now.

In the next few weeks we will also be funding new footballs for use by all the children in P.E and in after school football clubs. These are to replace the old ones as well as ensuring that we have the correct sizes for the age of the children. Every year the PTA funds Leavers Hoodies for the Year 6 children - we will start ordering these shortly.

The PTA will also be funding school banners for use at events such as Young Voices, inter-school sports events and Newport Carnival.
