Please talk to your child about club commitment. The children will need to speak to the adult who leads the club to inform them if they can't attend that week. If they no longer wish to attend the club, then it is the child's responsibility to inform the adult who leads the club and Mrs Green, so she can take them off the clubs register.

NB - Homework club is a place for children to complete their homework, a place to work in a calm environment, with the support of a teaching assistant, to complete any tasks that have already been set by the class teacher for completion at home.
