A Word from Mrs M....

Next week is National Anti-Bullying Week which we will be marking with some work and discussion in school.

The NSPCC define bullying: 'Bullying is behaviour that hurts someone else – such as name calling, hitting, pushing, spreading rumours, threatening or undermining someone. It can happen anywhere – at school, at home or online. It's usually repeated over a long period of time and can hurt a child both physically and emotionally. Bullying that happens online, using social networks, games and mobile phones, is often called cyberbullying. A child can feel like there's no escape because it can happen wherever they are, at any time of day or night.' We are also supporting Children in Need next Friday which is an appropriate ending to Anti-Bullying Week.

I'd like to congratulate the Year 5 and 6 pupils who represented the school at an athletics competition this week – they were commended on their excellent behaviour and sporting attitudes.

Polite reminder to parents, please can you ensure that children are waiting sensibly on the yard before the start of the school day.
