<u>A Word from our Head Teacher, Mrs Moody...</u> It is a priority to keep children safe and I have spoken to the children about procedures before and after school. Children are not supervised until the start of the school day at 8.50am. We recommend that children do not arrive before 8.40am.

If children bring a scooter or bike to school they are not to ride it once they enter the school gates as the yard is too congested and it poses a hazard. We ask that the children push their bike or scooter straight to the shelter and leave it there. Mobile phones are not to be used inside the school gates for safeguarding reasons.

We ask that the children follow the same procedures at the end of the day; not riding bikes or scooters until they are out of the gates and not using phones until they are off school site.

We would be very grateful for your support with this.
