

## English

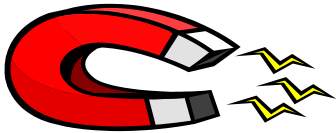

Children will develop skills in all four number operations, work on fractions and decimals, measuring. Children will develop skills in reasoning and problem solving.

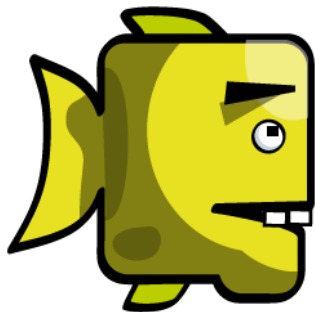
## Science
