You could include food, map, landmarks, famous people etc.</p> 	<p><u>Quiz</u></p> <p>Design a quiz for your family. You will need to think of a set of question and answers which can be grouped into categories. Perhaps you could include forfeits or bonus questions.</p>	<p><u>Practise your 6,7,8 and 12 times tables</u> – how fast can you recite them? Can you hold a family competition? This will be something talked about in history lessons of the future!</p>

Could you cook a meal or bake something for your family to share?</p>	<p><u>Portraits and Photography-</u> Take portrait photographs of your family members considering light and textures. Can you use the photographs to draw portraits in pen considering light and tone?</p> 	<p><u>Hand Written Letters</u></p>  <p>Can you write a letter to a friend or a family member who you can't see to cheer them up, perhaps you could include a picture or something you have made?</p>	<p><u>Organise an treasure hunt</u> There are lots on the internet to help but organise and write a scavenger hunt or a clue based treasure hunt for your whole family.</p>	<p><u>Can you create an Easter Garden?</u> Many churches and places of worship create Easter Gardens to remember and celebrate the sacrifice Jesus made. Use the internet to inspire you.</p> 
<p><u>Mapping Skills -</u> Identify the countries or cities within the UK where your family members originate from or live. Can you plot these on a map?</p> 	<p><u>Music</u> Write your own song/rap about something you are interested in.</p>	<p><u>Write an amazon book review.</u> What book have you read and loved recently?
