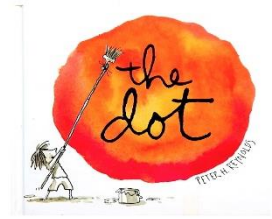
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










## The Dot

- Make sure the dot is still clear when your picture is finished.

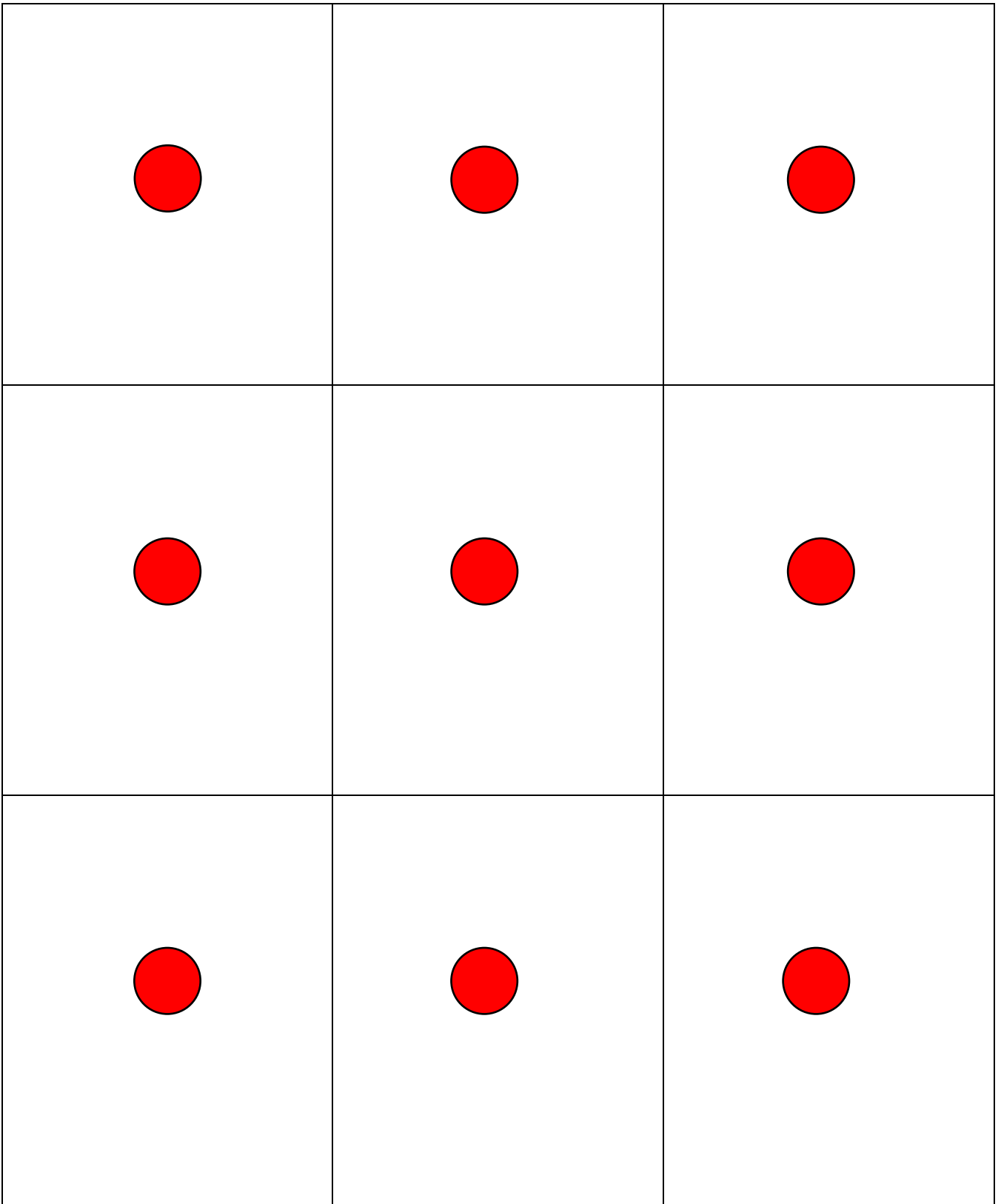

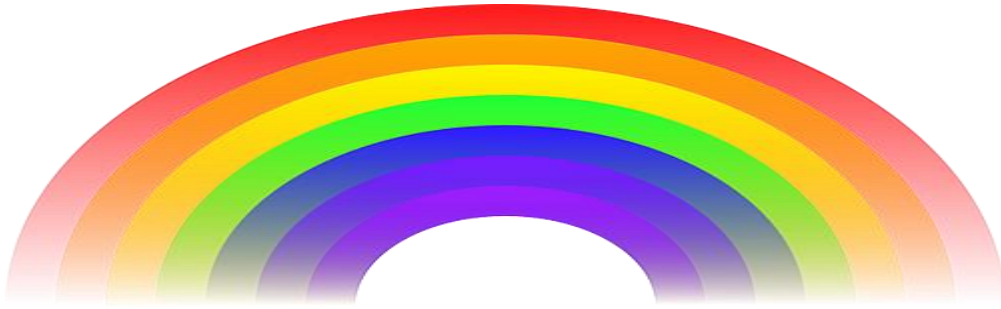
## Get musical

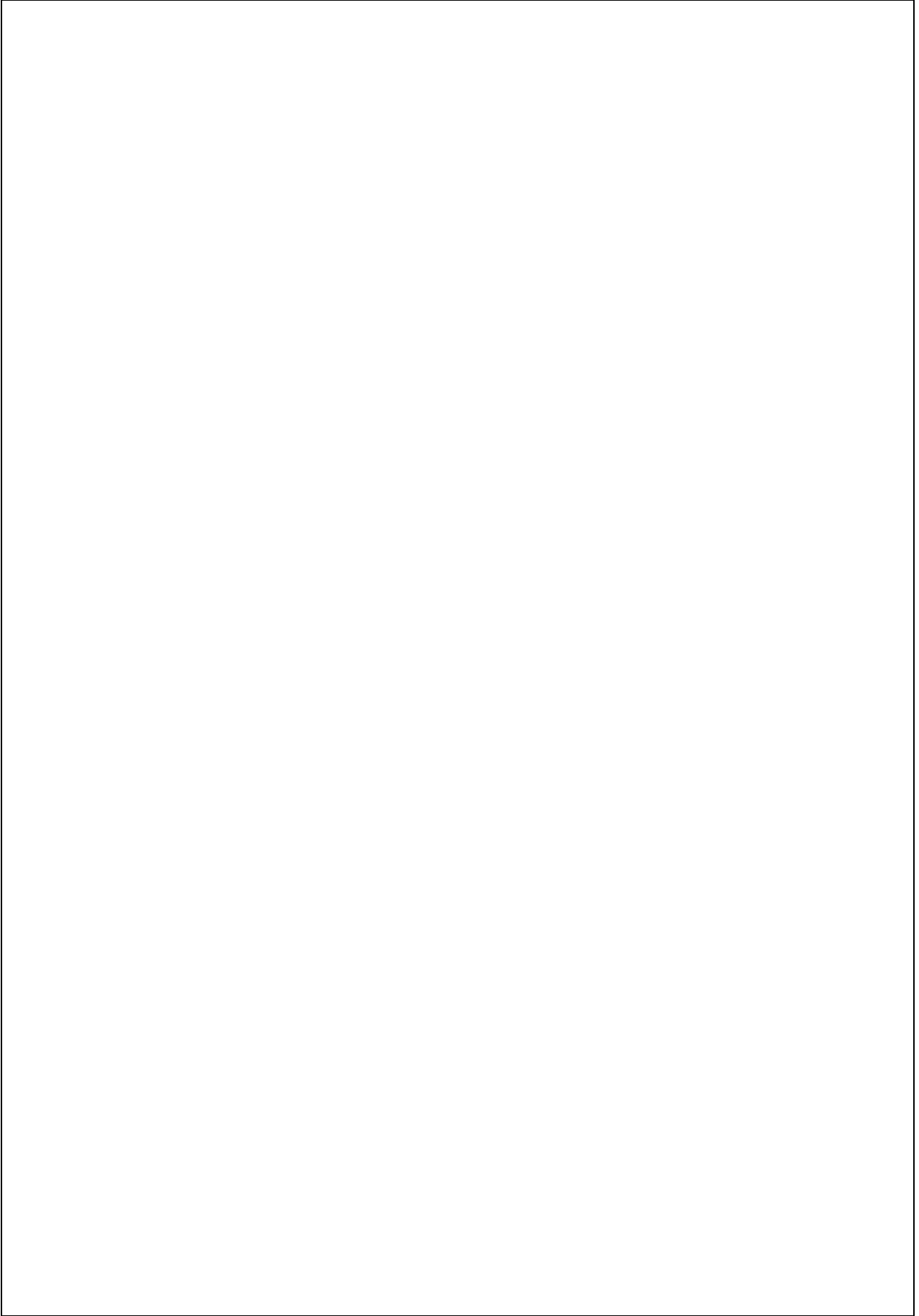
