Apostrophes are used to show possession.

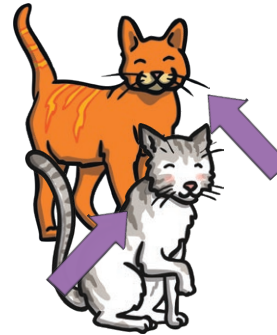
This is Amy's car.
