Ask someone at home to test you on how many you can remember.

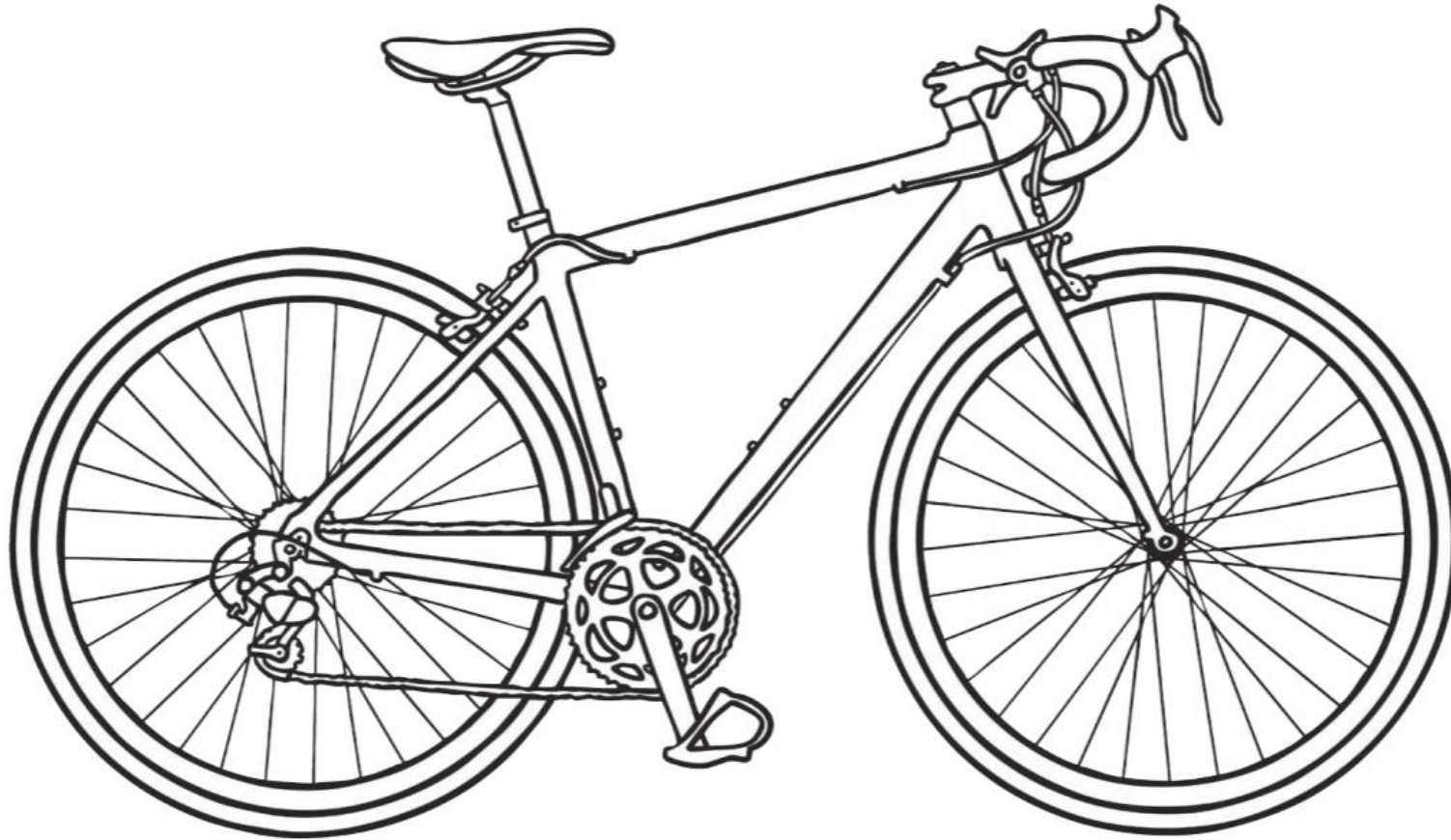
Do you know what any of these components are/do already?

| cassette     | handlebars   | rim       | spoke | rear derailleur  |
| front fork   | seat post    | stem      | tyre  | front derailleur |
| rear brake   | chainrings   | saddle    | crank | pedal            |
| front brake  | shift levers | spoke     | chain |                  |
| brake levers | handlebars   | seat tube | hub   |                  |

Using what you might know about these bike components can you add them to where you think they are found on the diagram below.

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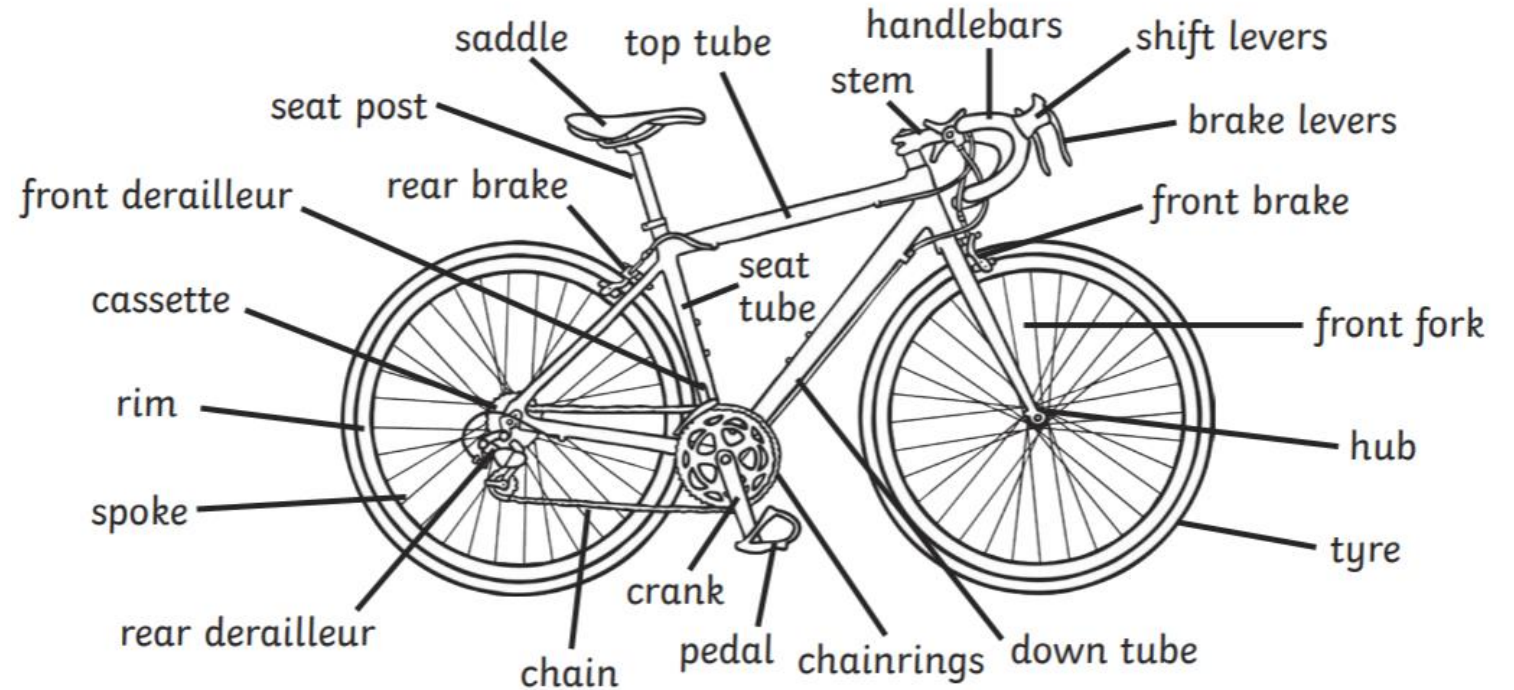
