

Mo says,

When I add hundreds to a number, only the hundreds column will change.



Is Mo correct? Explain your answer.

Show at least 3 examples to prove your point.

Top tip: Think about larger hundreds numbers, for example $833 + 200$

Another problem to solve:

I completed an addition and then used the inverse to check my calculation.

When I checked my calculation, the answer was 380

One of the other numbers was 520

What could the calculation be?

$$\underline{\quad} + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$$
