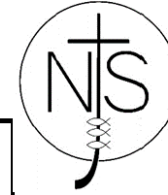


Home Study Learning,

Task 1... Sunflowers

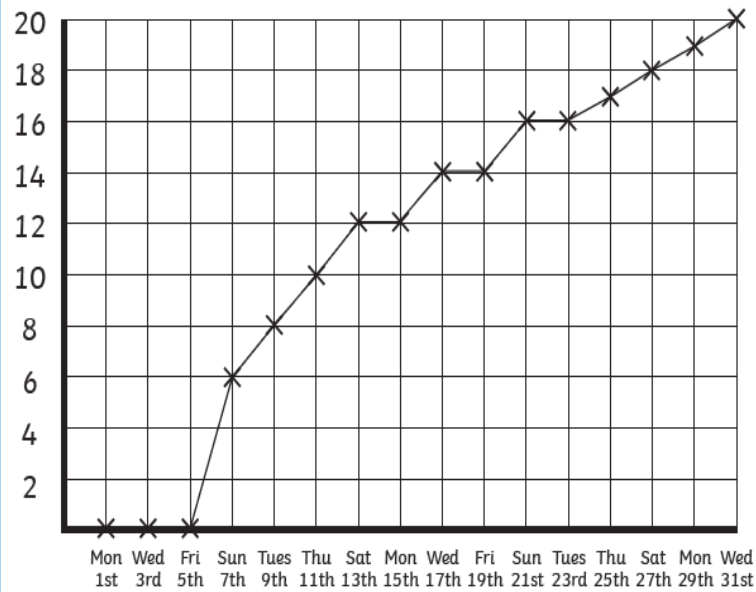
Remember to read the questions carefully!

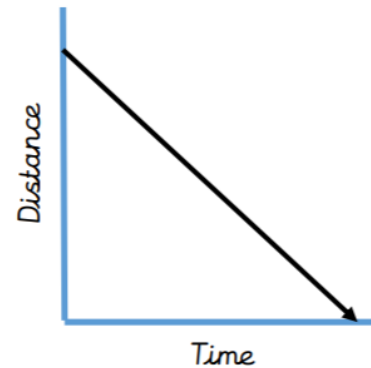
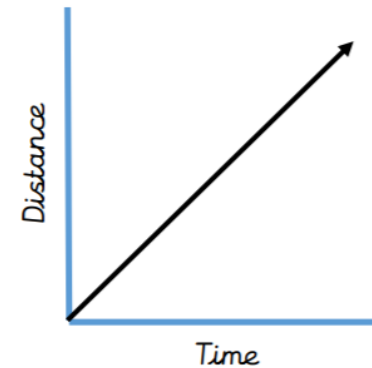
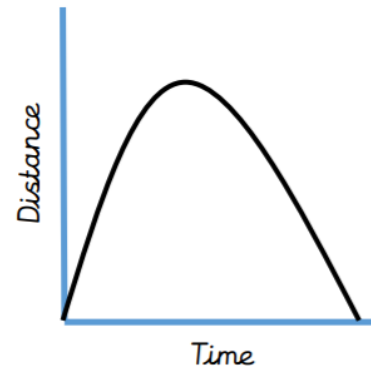
1. How many days did the plant take to grow to 18cm?

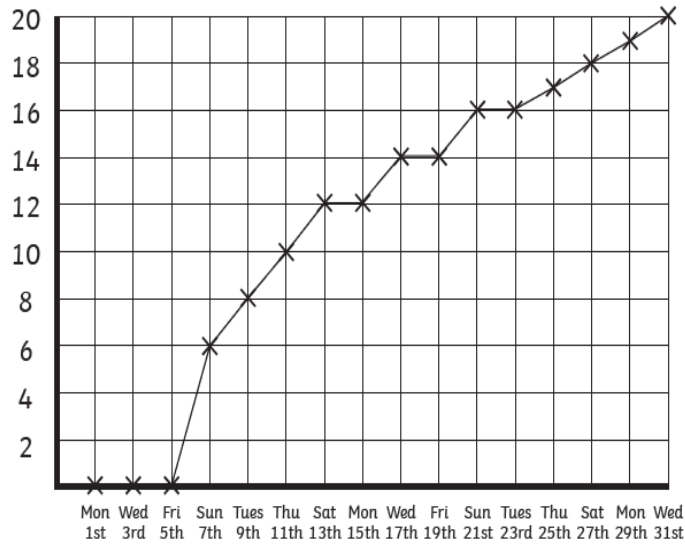

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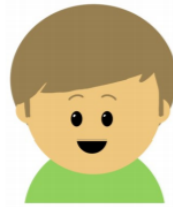
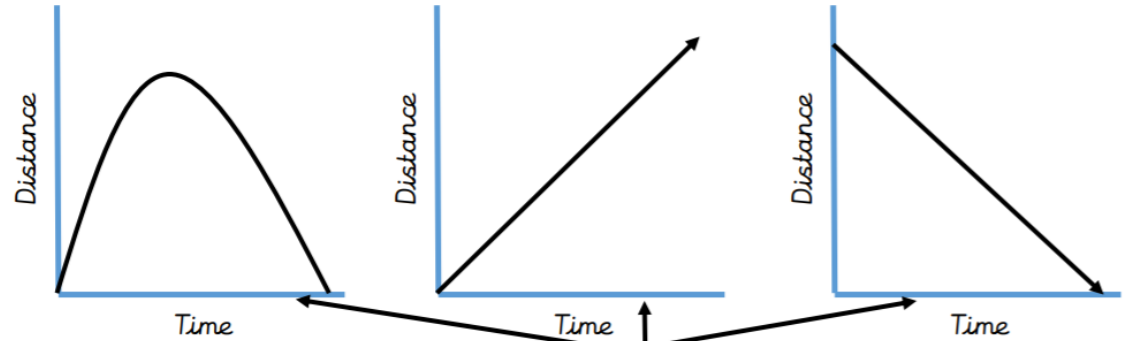
