

FAQ summer holiday clubs Covid-19

Thank you for choosing Activ8 and booking your child onto our summer clubs for 2020. We look forward to seeing you over the six weeks with lots of fun and activities planned for all.



COVID-19 means that our holiday clubs will run a little differently this summer.

The safety of your child and our staff is always our first priority so we have taken necessary precautions to make our clubs as safe as possible.

We've answered a number of FAQs in this document to help put your mind at ease.

Will children be working in bubbles?

Yes. Bubble sizes will vary depending on numbers of attendees, ranging from 8 – 15 with a designated team member for each bubble. There will also be a designated member of staff to greet you each morning and also direct you for collection at the end of each day.

Will my child be in a bubble with their friend/s?

Our plan is to allocate children into bubbles beforehand so they can join their bubble upon arrival, we will make sure at least one friend is within their bubble. Whilst it is important to operate within bubbles, we also want your child to have the best experience possible and we appreciate this will not be the case if they are in a bubble without knowing anyone else. If you do know of a friend that will be attending at the same time beforehand, please let us know in the comments box on the website when you book. Or alternatively email/ text/ call us to let us know.

Will Activ8 team members be the same every day?

Yes, staff will remain at the same location for the duration of the summer.

There will be two team members running, delivering and leading the activities. There will be one staff member for each bubble, catering for a maximum of 16 children within each of those bubbles.

There will also be one designated location coordinator.



Will PPE be used?

Should First Aid need to be administered, the location Coordinator will wear gloves and a face mask to administer this. The location Coordinator will also wear gloves and a face mask at registration when signing in/out. We have continued to deliver sports in schools throughout lockdown successfully following these guidelines. Staff will also be washing hand and using hand sanitiser on a very regular basis throughout the day

What cleaning procedures do you have in place?

We will have a designated location coordinator supervising the regular washing of hands, sterilising of equipment and cleaning of facilities throughout each club constantly throughout each day. At the end of each day the team will ensure the venue is clean ahead of the following day. Toilets will be cleaned numerous times throughout the day to ensure every child's safety whilst with Acitiv8. All staff have completed **'Infection Control and Cleaning Purposes Training'**



Will children use their own equipment or share with others?

There are a wide variety of activities and games that we can play safely with little to no equipment and wherever possible children will have their own equipment, for example their own Tennis Racket. Equipment will be cleaned thoroughly before being used by another bubble.

Can children bring their handheld games consoles for lunchtime?

Children are allowed to bring handheld games consoles for lunchtime, but will not be able to share with other children

What activities will children be doing?

There are a number of activities we can offer safely, adaptations of games, including tennis, golf, hockey, athletics, fitness circuits, target games, individual challenges



and arts and crafts. We can run skill drills for the likes of football and basketball, for example, children would have one ball per person. We are also planning to introduce a daily Mighty Maths session for children. This incorporates fitness along with maths.

Unfortunately team games which involve contact are not permitted at this time although this could change ahead of summer clubs commencing or during the summer itself. If this is the case then we will adapt our activities in line with guidance.

How will lunch and break times be managed?

Breaks throughout the day will be staggered for each bubble, ensuring washing of hands, usage of toilets along with drinks and snacks. Children will remain in contact with others within their bubble. Lunchtime will also be staggered, with one bubble eating slightly earlier than the other. Lunch will be for around 45mins, we will supply the screening of a U rated film for children to watch whilst eating. Wherever possible breaks and lunchtime will take place outside, using shaded areas if it is a hot day.

What does my child need to bring?

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and refillable water bottle.

Children should also wear suitable footwear and comfortable clothing. A jumper would be ideal as children will be outside for many activities throughout the day weather permitting.



How will registration and collection work?

The designated Camp Coordinator will greet you at the main school entrance and sign your child in/out. The Camp Coordinator will wear gloves and a facemask during registration in order to confirm your emergency contact numbers.

To maintain social distancing at registration and collection we will place floor markings 1M apart and we ask that parents do NOT enter venues.

During collection, the hub coordinator will direct you to the external door of the bubble your child has attended ready for collection.

What happens if a member of my household shows COVID-19 symptoms?

If someone within your household develops COVID-19 symptoms then we ask that you do not send your child to the Active Camp and follow Government guidance.

If your child develops a temperature, please do NOT send them to the holiday clubs. Wherever possible we would ask you to check your child's temperature in the morning before attending.



What happens if someone within a bubble shows COVID-19 symptoms?

If someone within one of our bubbles shows COVID-19 symptoms we will ask everyone within that bubble, including our team member to seek a COVID-19 test ASAP before returning to the club.

If the test returns negative then your child can return immediately however, should the test be positive, then you should follow Government guidance.

If a child shows any symptoms, they will be isolated with parents/ carers contacted until collection can be arranged in line with government guidelines.
