- Journeys: This unit will look at how we can use art to document our travels.



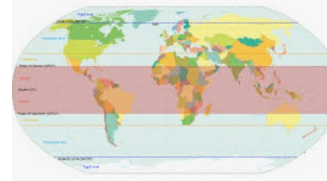
Term: Autumn 2020 Yr4
