RE: Yr 5 Residential Visit to Arthog Monday 8th-12th March 2021

Dear Parents,

I am writing to you regarding a residential visit to Arthog. This is our Year 5 residential and we have booked to take the Year 5's in March 2021 (please note that we have to book Arthog 2 years in advance and therefore the date has been booked since 2019). I have delayed this letter awaiting updates in COVID guidance, but I feel now is the time to write to you. I have been putting into place two plans which are outlined below:

Plan 1

Our booking to take place from Monday 8th to Friday 12th March 2021 for four nights at the Arthog Centre in Wales. During the visit the children will be taking part in a range of activities which will include, canoeing, rock climbing, orienteering, gorge walking and mountaineering amongst others.

The cost of the week will be £290. <u>Children who are receiving free school meals or whose parents receive Child Tax Credit/Income Support will be eligible for remissions supported by the LEA.</u> Evidence of this entitlement will need providing with the first deposit. **All payments are refundable if we are unable to attend the centre itself.**

If we can't go to ARTHOG WALES then ARTHOG WALES are going to bring the fun, challenge and adventure to us!!!

3 day experience including hill walk, rock climbing and canoeing in the local area (Shropshire/Staffordshire).

Groups of 10/12 children, Arthog instructor, Arthog buses to travel in and Arthog equipment (including waterproofs). All the Instructors will carry, and have access to PPE if they can not maintain social distancing. There will be Pre Visit Coronavirus checklist to be completed for our staff and your pupils/staff confirming no one has CV19 symptoms.
