eg. as excited as a puppy

as brave as a soldier

When you say something is something that it is similar to eg. I was an excited puppy I will be a brave soldier Poems contain **figurative language** to make them effective and powerful for the reader:

Personification

Alliteration

When you describe something that is not human as if it is human.

eg. the year ran away from us

the challenges tease us

When you put words together which start with the same letters. eg. wonderful wild winter sleeping snoozily on a sunny Saturday
