Poems contain **figurative language** to make them effective and powerful for the reader:

Similes

When you compare something to being like or as as something else that it is similar to.

eg. as excited as a puppy

as brave as a soldier

Metaphors

When you say something is something that it is similar to

eg. I was an excited puppy

I will be a brave soldier

Poems contain **figurative language** to make them effective and powerful for the reader:

Personification

When you describe something that is not human as if it is human.

eg. the year ran away from us
the challenges tease us

Alliteration

When you put words together which start with the same letters.

eg. wonderful wild winter
sleeping snoozily on a sunny
Saturday
