Foundation; Science: Day and Night

For this lesson you will need a torch, a globe, blu-tac or something similar and a small object the size of a marble (if you do not have a globe a ball with the continents and the UK drawn on it will do!)

What to do:

1. Find where you live on the globe. Using the sticky tack, attach the small object to the location.
2. Shine the torch on your location. Then, rotate the globe anticlockwise.
3. Remember to hold the torch still.
4. Then observe what happens to the torch light / our location!
