Title - Isadora Moon goes Camping

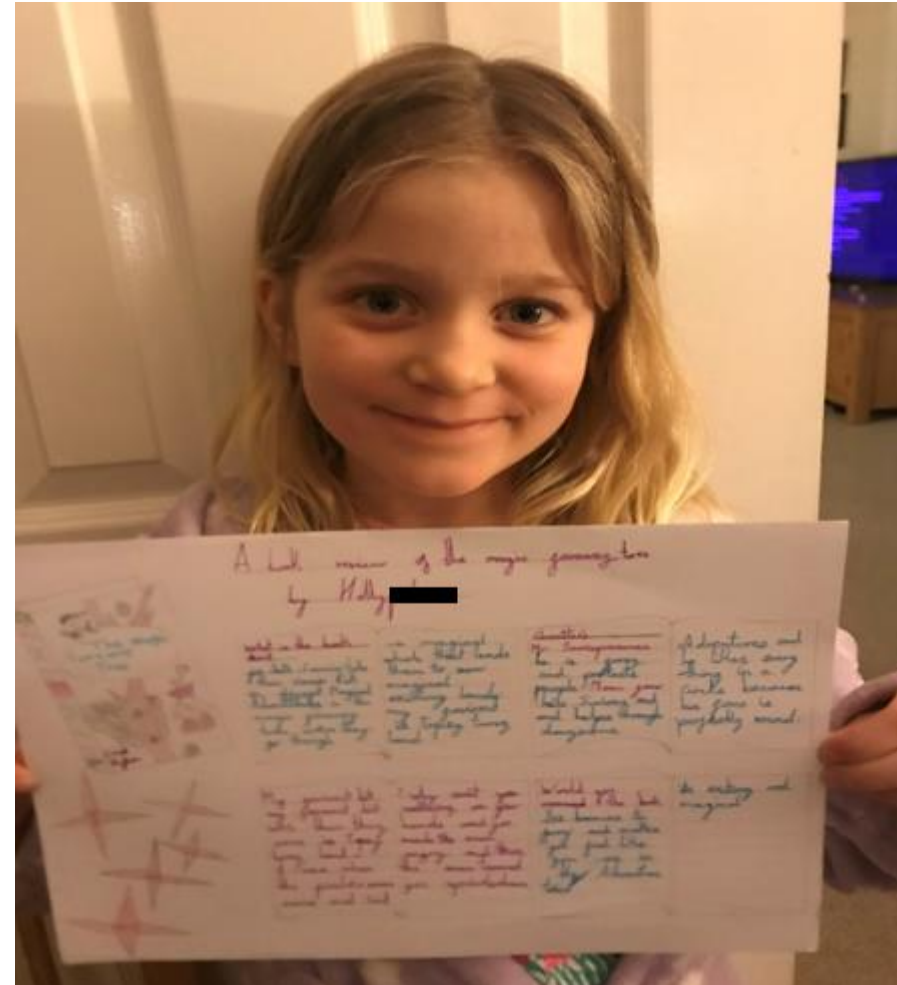
It's about a girl who is half vampire and half fairy.

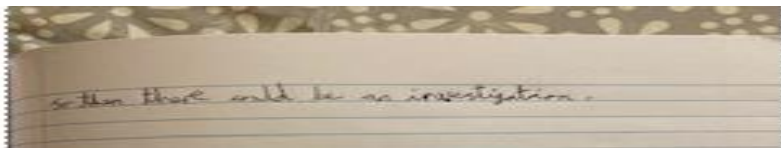

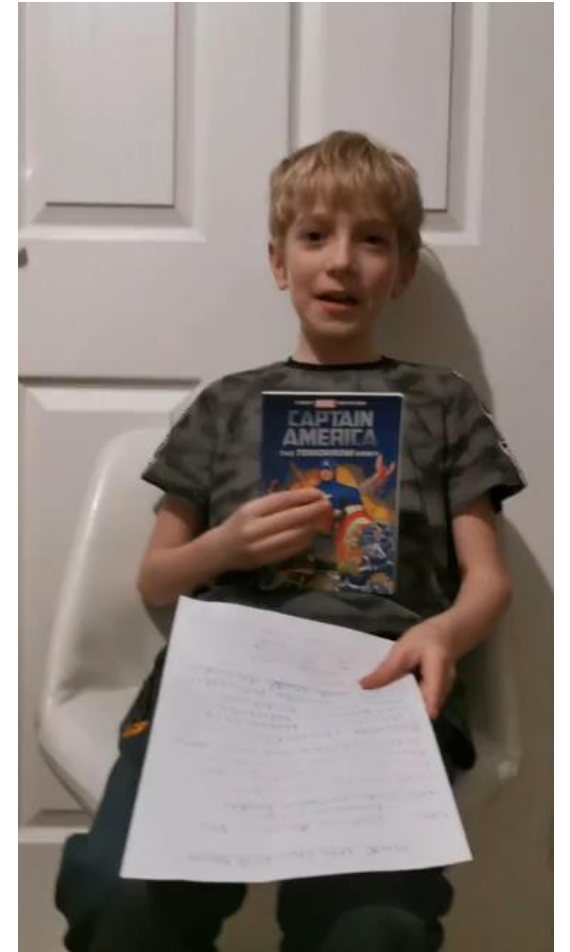

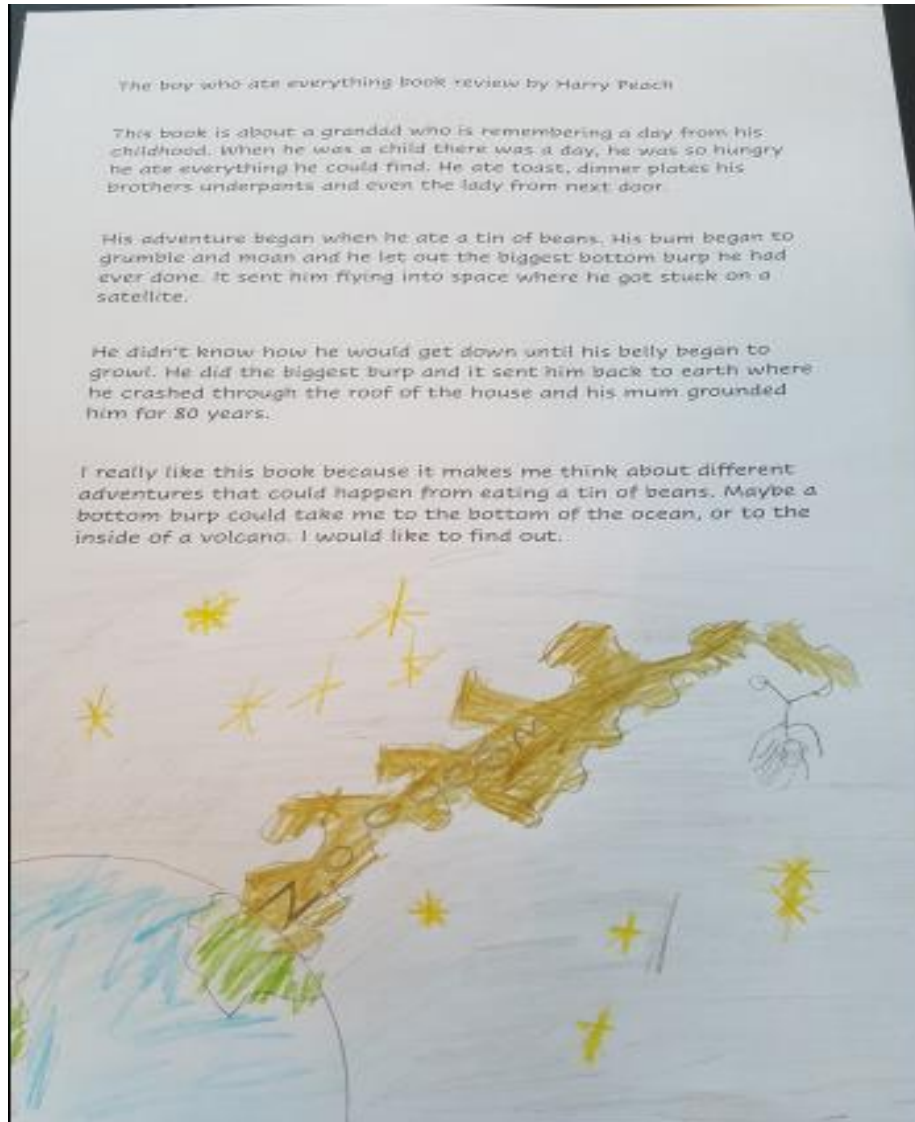
