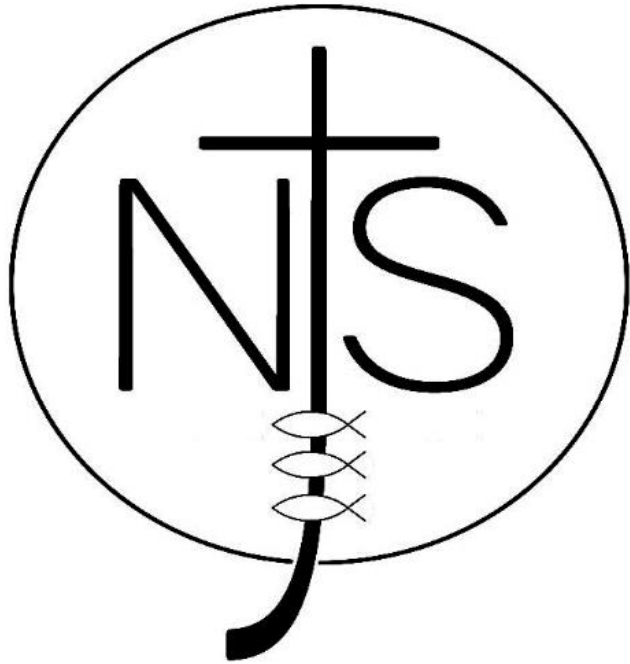

NO electrical items or mobile phones.

<p>All children will be expected to come to school dressed ready for their activities (forest school style clothes). The children will also be expected to wear wellies. All the kit below will be carried, by the children, in one rucksack, containing: ONE complete changes of clothes, including: warm jerseys/ sweat shirts, long trousers/joggers, a T-shirt and thick socks & underwear. <i>NB: Jeans are not suitable for this trip</i> When packing please try to bear in mind the weather forecasts and adjust your clothing accordingly AND remember they have to carry their own bags to Edgmond.</p>	
<p>Footwear: Trainers for indoors and some games.</p>	
<p>Washing Bag: With toothbrush & toothpaste soap & flannel / comb and /or brush. Please don't bring shower stuff - it is only one night, or smelly sprays some people who get asthma are affected by them.</p>	
<p>Nightwear/PJ's</p>	
<p>A small towel</p>	
<p>Screw topped, plastic, drink container</p>	
<p>Teddy/comforter/pillow case - something familiar</p>

* If you would like your child to go we need you to sign the permission slip today and leave a £30 deposit to secure the place or by Friday 26th November.

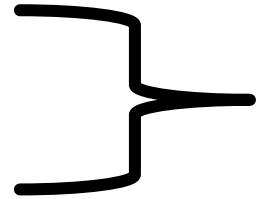
* The remaining £50 needs to be paid by the Friday 11th February 2022.
