You said..

98% agree that your child is happy at school.

We did...

We always do and will continue to monitor this closely with pupil voice: getting regular feedback from our children is a priority for all staff. Happy children will be successful.

You said...

98% agree that your child feels safe at school.

We did...

Safeguarding is our priority. We are continually monitoring safeguarding practise and procedure and will continue to do so. We will remind our families if they ever have a concern about safeguarding to contact us immediately.

You said...

88% agree that the school deals with bullying effectively.

We did...

Pupil voice tells us that the children know what to do if they, or someone they know, is being bullied and they can tell us how staff respond. We have completed our annual review of our Anti Bullying Policy in consultation with school staff. We recently marked Anti Bullying week and relationship education is built in throughout our curriculum. Guardians of Safety have just released some videos providing clarity for our school community around what bullying is. Next they will be producing posters to remind us all what we can expect to happen should bullying occur. We want everyone to understand the content of our Anti Bullying Policy.

You said...

98% agree that the school makes parents aware of what the children are learning.

We did...

We will continue to share updates on our website and ensure the 'Curriculum' page on our website is highlighted to parents.

You said...

94% agree that concerns are dealt with effectively by the school.

We did...

We will remind parents and carers about contact details to make us aware if you have a concern. We will remind our community that staff are available to speak with at the start and end of the school day, by email and telephone.

You said...

80% of parents and carers with a child on the SEND register felt that their child was appropriately supported.

We did...

We continue to engage with our SEND parents through feedback forms from provision maps, SEND coffee meetings, SEND newsletter and the opportunity, at anytime, to make contact with school staff to discuss provision in place. Internal observations show that the needs of SEND pupils are well met through adaptation and intervention and their progress is being closely monitored.

94% feel that their child is doing well at this school.

We did...

We are proud of the achievements of all of our children. We will ensure assessment expectations are shared with our families so they can understand how well their child is doing compared to the expected standard.
