On Monday 4th March there will be a book themed assembly where teachers will be sharing book recommendations and I will introduce a **Design a Book Cover Competition**.

A Book Swap will be held on Tuesday 5th March. Children may bring in a book and swap it for another book. We ask children to bring in a book they would like to swap on Monday 4th March so they can be organised and grouped ready for the Tuesday Book Swap Day. Once they hand in a book, they will be given a raffle ticket they can exchange for a new book at the Book Swap on Tuesday 5th March.
