- 1) One weekend, 2,576 people go to watch a football team play. The next match, 981 people come to watch them. How many people watched them in total over both games?
- 2) A man has £4,245. He spends £82. How much money does he have left?
- 3) A school had 356 glue sticks. By half-term, 72 of the glue sticks were used up or broken, so they were thrown away. How many were left?
- 4) A man weighs 72.4Kg. He gains 2.8Kg. How much does he weigh now?
- 5) Sara and Abeda have a competition to see who can swim the furthest without stopping. Sara swims 2.2Km and Abeda swims 1.8Km. How much further did Sara swim than Abeda?
- 6) Samiha is 136.8cm tall. Monica is 118.4cm tall. How much shorter is Monica than Samiha?
- 7) The temperature was -4°C. It increases by 9°C. What is it now?
- 8) At the start of the year, there are 420 children in a school. Over the year, 30 children leave the school and 16 join it. How many children are in the school at the end of the year?
- 9) Alif has £6.20. He spends £1.30 on a chocolate bar and 36p on an apple. How much money does he still have?
- 10) A car has 45.4 litres of fuel. It uses 8.1 litres of fuel, then adds 19.8 litres of fuel at a petrol station. How much fuel is in its tank now?
