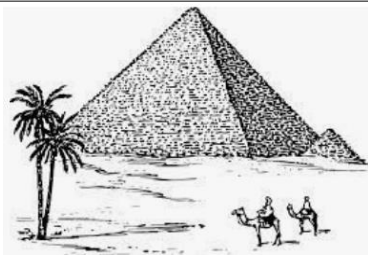


## History



### The Egyptians

Children will learn about:

- The chronology of world history.
- Pharaohs
- Mummification,
- Gods and Goddess
- Hieroglyphs
- Cleopatra

The children will also cover the six schema Invasion, Monarchy, Settlement, Pioneers, Kingdom, Religion.

## Year 3 Spring Term 2025

This term we will be studying the Egyptians and their impact on world history. Work in many subjects will have a 'Egyptian' focus, including English, Computing, Art and Design & Technology.

## The Egyptians

### Maths

Children will develop skills in:

- Number - Multiplication and Division.
- Measurement - Length and Perimeter.
- Number - Fractions
- Geometry - Shape including angles.

Children will also be completing Number Sense a maths programme teaching the children times tables facts thus improving their timetables knowledge.

### Science

This term the children will learn about:

- Digestion.
- Teeth
- Habitats and classification.

### English

Children will focus on:

- Impending threat story narrative.
- Sentence structure
- Spellings, punctuation and grammar.
- Stories with a historical setting.
- Egyptian narrative story
- Handwriting

### Guided Reading

This term, our whole class reading is The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We use the VIPERS scheme to progress reading and comprehension skills.

- Vocabulary
  - Inference
  - Prediction
  - Explain
  - Retrieval
  - Summarise
- Children will also read a class reader with their teacher.

### PE

- Gymnastics, Dance, Swimming & Tag Rugby

### PSHE

- Children will learn about what makes them special, differences, likes and dislikes, what they are good at, managing friendships and worries and tolerance.

### Computing

Children will use Scratch programming to move a sprite, create mazes, draw lines and features, debug programs and complete a coding project. Children will also create a stop motion animation, using iPads, looking a framing and composing skills, changing and adding effects and producing a project piece linked to their Egyptian work.

### Other

- Daily mindfulness
- Daily prayer and reflection time
- Weekly walk and talk



### Geography

- Children will learn about the UK, focusing on rivers, mountains, counties and cities.
- The children will start to learn the difference between human and physical geography.

### Music

- Castles - children will begin to internalise key musical skills and techniques through a range of practical based activities including call and response songs, chants and movements.
- In the Garden - children will be learning how to combine both rhythm and pitch notation over three notes (C, D, E) to create a simple melody.

### MFL- French

- Animals
- Carnival & Numbers.

### Art

- Making papyrus pictures
- Replicating Egyptian Cartouches using hieroglyphics
- Creating Egyptian necklaces
- Butterfly art and printing techniques.

### Design and Technology

- Learn ancient skills to develop an Egyptian product.
- Discuss food groups and their relation to healthy eating.
- Create a food-based product.
