Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to invite your child to take part on NJS' Newport Carnival float. This takes place on Saturday 14th June. This year the Carnival theme is "Let's Get Creative" and we have chosen to follow a Festival theme with a creative celebration of music and craft!

We would like the children to dress up in bright festival style clothing (think Hawaiian shirts or neon) and to create a piece of headwear out of recycling! (This could be a top hat, bucket hat, fascinator... anything to wear on their head made out of recycling!)



If your child would like to take part we would need them to arrive at BBS Car Park for 11am. The children will then need collecting from the lorry park on Salters Lane at the end of the procession at 1pm (you must be prompt to collect as we cannot wait here long). Prizes will then be awarded around 1.30pm from the main stage on the High Street.

NJS are very proud to have entered the carnival for a number of years. It is a very enjoyable day for both staff and children and we hope many of the children are able to take part. However, due to health and safety restrictions we will only be allowing around 50 children on our float - these places will be assigned on a first come first served basis.
