On **Wednesday 5th November**, the Year 3 children have the opportunity to visit the Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre, Craven Arms as part of our History topic 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. We aim to leave school at 9:00 am and will return to school by the end of the school day 3:00/3:15pm. This is due to be a fantastic experience for the children and they will benefit from real life artefacts during different workshops.

In the morning, the children will be taking part in a cave painting, spear throwing and fire bows, before visiting the secret hills exhibition including the Shropshire Wooly mammoth encounter and Iron Age experience. In the afternoon the children will have further "have a go" activities as Iron Age children.

Children will require a packed lunch for this trip and will need to be at school promptly for 8:45am for departure at 9:00am. Any children who are in receipt of free school meals will have a meal provided for them from our school kitchen.
