The author of this lovely book will be visiting us during Book Week!

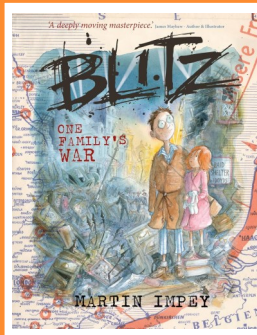

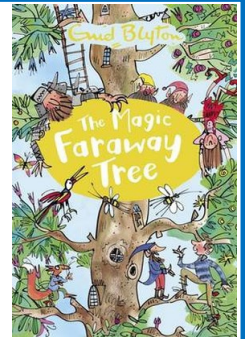

Author Profile- Ross Montgomery

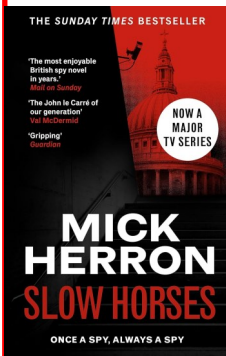
