Year 6 Residential Trip to London

We are delighted to announce an exciting **three-day educational visit to London** for our Year 6 pupils in June 2026.

To give **more children the opportunity to attend** and to ensure that every pupil can fully benefit from the experience, we will be running **two identical London trips** this year:

- **Trip 1:** 9th June to 11th June 2026
- **Trip 2:** 16th June to 18th June 2026

Both visits will follow the same itinerary and provide pupils with the same exciting opportunities to explore London.

Why Your Child Will Love This Trip

Over three action-packed days, pupils will explore some of London's most famous landmarks and attractions, enjoy a West End theatre performance and cruise along the River Thames.

Highlights include:

- Exploring the fascinating exhibits at the Natural History Museum.
- Visiting the magnificent St Paul's Cathedral, including the Crypt and Galleries.
- Enjoying a River Thames boat cruise
- Discovering the history and treasures of the Tower of London.
- Seeing the spectacular West End production of **The Lion King**
- Participating in an interactive Shakespeare and Macbeth workshop at the Globe Theatre.
- Experiencing breathtaking views of the capital on the London Eye.

Parents wishing for their child to attend should complete the sign-up process on parentpay and pay an **initial holding deposit of £20 by Tuesday 15th September 2026**. Once numbers have been confirmed, children will be allocated to one of the two trips, taking friendship groups and other practical considerations into account wherever possible.

If the visit is oversubscribed, places will be allocated through a fair random draw. Any deposits paid by pupils who are not allocated a place will be refunded in full.

The total cost of the trip is **£579**, which includes all travel, accommodation, meals and activities. Payments can be made either in full or in instalments via **ParentPay**.

Please note that **all payments are non-refundable**, as per the Charging & Remissions Policy, as we will have committed to accommodation, transport and activity bookings on your child's behalf. Any remaining balance may be refunded if we are able to fill the place from the waiting list.

We are committed to ensuring that all children have the opportunity to take part in this memorable experience. Therefore, pupils who are eligible for **Pupil Premium funding** will be entitled to a **50% reduction in the total cost of the trip**. Further details regarding payment schedules and the discounted contribution will be provided once places have been confirmed.

We want every child to be able to enjoy this fantastic learning experience. If the cost of the trip may present a difficulty for your family, please do not hesitate to contact our School Business Manager, Mrs Jennie Fisher, in confidence.
